**Summary:** FEMA has issued a disaster declaration update for DR-4542 in the state of South Carolina, adding two counties for a total of nine with individual assistance. CMG's disaster policy is in effect for these counties.

#### **South Carolina Severe Storms, Tornadoes, And Straight-line Winds (DR-4542)**

Incident Period: April 12, 2020 - April 13, 2020

Major Disaster Declaration declared on May 01, 2020

**Designated Counties (Individual Assistance):** Aiken, Barnwell, Berkeley, Colleton, Hampton, Marlboro, Oconee, Orangeburg, Pickens

Since there is an end date, FHA loans are eligible for re-inspection at this time. If the effective date of the appraisal is on or after the date required above for an inspection, a separate damage inspection report is not necessary.
