HURRICANE SALLY SUSPENSIONS & OTHER DISASTER UPDATES

Summary: The following counties are suspended as of the end of business 9/15/2020 due to the pending impact of Hurricane Sally:

Mississippi: Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, Pearl River, Stone, George

Alabama: Mobile, Baldwin, Washington, Clarke, Monroe

Louisiana: Saint Tammany, Orleans, Saint, Bernard, Plaquemines

Florida: Escambia, Santa Rosa

Once the impact is assessed, additional updates will be provided.

In addition, based on FEMA declarations for individual assistance, the following counties are added to the disaster list:

California: Butte County (DR 4558)

Louisiana: Caddo, La Salle, St. Landry (DR 4559)

As a reminder, the following counties continue to be suspended due to fire activity:

Oregon (fires): Clackamas County, Douglas County, Jackson, Klamath, Lane, Lincoln, Linn, Marion, Wasco

Washington (fires): Chelan, Douglas, Lincoln, Okanogan, Spokane, Whitman, Yakima
